1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Talbot County – Hotel Rental Tax – Time of Penalty for Nonpayment**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of time that a hotel has to pay the hotel rental tax
4 in Talbot County before incurring a penalty; and generally relating to the hotel
5 rental tax in Talbot County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Local Government**

14 20–426.

15 (a) Except in [Talbot County or] Wicomico County, if a hotel fails to pay the hotel
16 rental tax to a county within 1 month after the payment is due under § 20–410 of this
17 subtitle, the hotel shall pay a tax penalty of 10% of the unpaid tax.

1 (b) If a hotel fails to pay the hotel rental tax to [Talbot County or] Wicomico
2 County within 120 days after the payment is due under § 20–410 of this subtitle, the hotel
3 shall pay a tax penalty of 10% of the unpaid tax.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
5 1, 2025.
