3 FOR the purpose of expanding the scope of the annual young-of-the-year juvenile survey
4 of striped bass or rockfish by requiring the Department of Natural Resources to
5 conduct the survey at at least a certain number of additional sampling sites in the
6 central region of the Maryland waters of the Chesapeake Bay ~~in addition to sampling~~
7 ~~sites in the northern and southern regions of the Maryland waters of the Chesapeake~~
8 ~~Bay; establishing certain requirements for the central region sampling sites; and~~
9 generally relating to striped bass or rockfish.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

~~(A) (1) The Department shall conduct annually a scientific survey to determine the relative abundance of striped bass or rockfish of approximately 18 inches in length that are in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries.~~

~~(2) The survey shall be conducted in areas that are used by the Department to determine its young-of-the-year index of striped bass or rockfish.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

4-746.

(A) IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4-215 OF THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT SCIENTIFIC MONITORING TO COLLECT BIOLOGICAL INFORMATION TO DETERMINE THE RELATIVE ABUNDANCE OF STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH IN AREAS THROUGHOUT THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TIDAL TRIBUTARIES.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

~~(1) CONDUCT THE ANNUAL YOUNG-OF-THE-YEAR JUVENILE SURVEY OF STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH AT BETWEEN 12 AND 20, INCLUSIVE, SAMPLING SITES LOCATED IN THE CENTRAL REGION OF THE MARYLAND WATERS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY IN ADDITION TO SAMPLING SITES IN THE NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN REGIONS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY; AND~~

~~(2) LOCATE THE CENTRAL REGION SAMPLING SITES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WATERS OF THE STATE:~~

(1) CONDUCT SAMPLING USING THE SAME OR EQUIVALENT METHODS AS THE YOUNG-OF-THE-YEAR JUVENILE INDEX SURVEY OF STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH IN AT LEAST TWO SITES LOCATED IN THE CENTRAL REGION OF THE MARYLAND WATERS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TIDAL TRIBUTARIES; AND

(2) LOCATE THE CENTRAL REGION SAMPLING SITES IN AREAS OTHER THAN THE AREAS SAMPLED FOR THE YOUNG-OF-THE-YEAR JUVENILE INDEX SURVEY OF STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH AND IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WATERS OF THE STATE:

(I) THE MAGOTHY RIVER;

(II) THE SEVERN RIVER;

(III) THE CHESTER RIVER;

(IV) THE SOUTH RIVER;

(V) THE WEST RIVER;

(VI) EASTERN BAY; ~~OR~~

(VII) THE MILES RIVER;

(VIII) THE PATAPSCO RIVER;

(IX) THE RHODE RIVER; OR

(X) THE TRED AVON RIVER.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4–215 OF THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT SCIENTIFIC MONITORING TO COLLECT BIOLOGICAL INFORMATION TO DETERMINE THE RELATIVE ABUNDANCE OF STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH IN AREAS THROUGHOUT THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TIDAL TRIBUTARIES.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Natural Resources shall annually examine the survey data collected under § 4–746(b) of the Natural Resources Article, as enacted under Section 2 of this Act, to ensure the distribution of striped bass or rockfish has not shifted from the established sites of the young-of-the-year juvenile index survey of striped bass or rockfish.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31 each year, the Department of Natural Resources shall report its results from its examination of the survey data conducted under Section 4 of this Act to the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission, the Tidal Fisheries Advisory Commission, and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the Senate Committee on Education, Energy, and the Environment and the House Environment and Transportation Committee.

1 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 3 of this Act shall take
2 effect July 1, 2027.

3 SECTION ~~2~~ 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in
4 Section 6 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025. Sections 2, 4, and 5 of this Act
5 shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2027,
6 Sections 2, 4, and 5 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
7 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
